

School Climate

Potential parent priority: Parent-driven metrics that support a positive school climate, specifically citywide school discipline and attendance policies.

What is School Climate?

Defined by the National School Climate Center, school climate is the "quality and character of school life," which impacts the experiences of students and school staff.



What's the current state of key aspects of school climate in DC: discipline and attendance policies?

School discipline

- Despite only making up 66% of the student body, **Black students make up more than 90% of students who receive out-of-school suspensions** in school year 2018-2019.
- Students in special education made up more than 30% of students with out-of-school suspensions, even though only 16% of all DC students receive special education services and supports.

Attendance

- During school year 2021-2022, almost half of all students, 48%, missed 10% or more of school.
- This lower attendance rate came from many reasons, including COVID-19 absences, mental health issues, and issues adjusting back to in-person learning.
